# VA Homemaker & Home Health Aide (H/HHA) Program

Veterans may be eligible for VA-funded in-home support if they have:

- A clinical need for personal care assistance or supervision
- A referral made by their VA Patient Aligned Care Team (PACT) or primary care provider
- A service plan authorized directly by the VA

This program is designed to support Veterans who require help with daily activities to remain safe and independent at home.

## About VA Benefits & Eligibility

The VA determines all eligibility for Community Care programs. Veterans interested in exploring whether they may qualify should speak directly with their VA care team.

- Assistance with daily personal care
- Homemaker services
- Respite care for family caregivers
- Support for maintaining independence at home

Please contact your VA PACT or clinic for questions about eligibility or available services.



## How to Get Started

If you are a Veteran seeking home care services:

- Contact your VA PACT or primary care provider
- Discuss your care needs and possible eligibility
- The VA will determine whether home care services are appropriate and will coordinate any authorized referrals directly
